


HISTORY OF LONE MOUNTAIN RANCH

For over 100 years, Lone Mountain Ranch has been a historic symbol of the American West. It played a role in the early days of Yellowstone Park, the formation of the town of Big Sky, the evolution of ranching and logging in the Northern Rockies and the preservation of the American West's spectacular wilderness. The Ranch was homesteaded by Clarence Lytle in 1915 as a working cattle and hay cutting ranch. A number of the current structures were originally built during the Ranch's first decade.

ABRAHAM LINCOLN, 1864

In 1927, the Ranch was sold to a Chicago paper mill executive, J. Fred Butler, who transformed the Ranch into a private vacation retreat for his family. In the 1930s, the next generation of the Butler family opened the Ranch to outside guests drawn to its spectacular natural setting and authentic western atmosphere. Following the Second World War, Lone Mountain Ranch was used as the base of a logging operation but in 1955 was converted back to a guest ranch.

In the early 1970s, the Ranch was purchased by a group of influential figures and investors developing the town of Big Sky.

News anchor and Montana native Chet Huntley, ski legend Warren Miller and senior executives from Chrysler Corporation, Conoco and others entertained visitors at Lone Mountain Ranch and used the Ranch as their headquarters. In 1977, the Schaap family bought the Ranch to develop its potential as a mecca for cross country skiing. Over the next thirty years, they refined the Ranch's year-round guest experience, building upon the Ranch's rich heritage, natural beauty and numerous amenities. They also succeeded in solidifying Lone Mountain Ranch's position as a premier Nordic ski destination when the Ranch was rated #1 in North America by Cross Country Skiing Magazine.

In 2013, the Ranch was purchased by Auric Road who have restored and repositioned the property as a world class luxury guest ranch which is a frequent host to leading business executives, political leaders, celebrities and thought leaders from around the globe.

The Ridge

The Ridge offers sweeping 360-degree views of the surrounding mountains and valleys, including stunning sightlines to Lone Peak, creating an unforgettable backdrop for wedding ceremonies and receptions. Rising 500 feet above the main ranch, the Ridge is an easy 15-minute walk from Horn & Cantle, though most wedding parties choose to shuttle guests to the top. A local events company is required to provide seating – benches, chairs, or hay bales – as well as any tenting needed for the celebration. Brides may arrive in our dedicated wedding carriage, and the full wedding party can make a memorable entrance together by horse-drawn wagon.








Auric Room 1915

We envisioned a place for adventurers to relax, dine, and share stories over a great whiskey at the end of the day. The private dining venue with booths, banquet tables, a bar, private kitchen and cigar terrace is clad in reclaimed oak flooring and timber walls with modern elements like a thick black marble bar suspended on an ebonized base. This venue is open to private buyouts on a limited basis that can accommodate up to 36 guests for seated dinners and cocktail receptions for up to 45 guests.


Bison Lodge

Introducing Bison Lodge at Lone Mountain Ranch — the pinnacle of Western alpine living.


Perched on a private ridge with sweeping views of Lone Mountain and the ranch below, Bison Lodge is one of the premier event spaces on the property — an elevated Montana home designed for unforgettable wedding parties and intimate celebrations. Its expansive outdoor living areas, totaling 2,700 square feet, can accommodate up to 30 guests for welcome gatherings, rehearsal dinners, cocktail hours, or relaxed post-wedding moments around the fire. The poolside terrace adds another memorable setting, perfect for casual afternoon lunches, grilling sessions, or family-style meals at a large outdoor dining table.

Inside, the 5,000-square-foot lodge provides a polished yet comfortable backdrop for wedding-day preparations and group time together. With six king bedrooms — including a dedicated Alaskan King bunk suite — and six full bathrooms, the home supports wedding parties with plenty of space to spread out. The great room captures Big Sky sunsets, while the open kitchen and 12-seat indoor dining table create a natural hub for shared meals and toasts. Additional entertainment spaces — including a vinyl listening lounge and a separate game room — offer late-night flexibility, and a convertible king bedroom can serve as an office, nursery, yoga room, or prep suite for the wedding party.

Thoughtful amenities elevate every gathering: five fireplaces, spa-style bathrooms, a heated year-round private infinity pool and hot tub overlooking the mountains, a private sauna, and expansive decks ideal for morning coffee or evening stargazing. With its blend of privacy, scenery, and beautifully designed spaces, Bison Lodge is an exceptional venue for weddings.

Lytle Bar & Patio

This intimate eight-seat bar tucked inside The Outpost honors Clarence Lytle, the ranch's original homesteader. It opens onto a heated deck with firepits, offering views toward The Ridge and a central location between The Tack Room, The Outpost, and Horn & Cantle. It's an ideal gathering spot for pre-dinner drinks before private Sleigh Ride Dinners in winter, or for sunset cocktails throughout the summer months. The spacious deck accommodates up to 60 guests and has been used for live music, DJ-led après ski parties, and a range of outdoor celebrations.


Chipmunk

Set along the banks North Fork Creek, its weathered logs bear the marks of nearly a century of Montana seasons — long winters blanketed in snow, golden summers alive with birdsong. 






Porcupine









Meadowlark



This spacious one-bedroom retreat is tucked among lodgepole pines and framed by the Gallatin Mountains



From the private porch, guests can watch the light move across the hills and listen to the breeze in the pines.














Bull Moose


On the lower level, a six-person sauna provides welcome relief after horseback riding or skiing, rounding out a home that blends Montana independence with relaxed, refined comfort.









