Though immersed in nature, Lone Mountain Ranch is just five minutes from Big Sky Town Center, placing shops, dining, and a vibrant lineup of local events within easy reach. Located just 45 minutes from Bozeman, Big Sky offers remarkable ease of access without sacrificing its sense of escape. It is a destination that feels at once expansive, unhurried, and unforgettable.



HISTORY OF LONE MOUNTAIN RANCH

For over 100 years, Lone Mountain Ranch has been a historic symbol of the American West. It played a role in the early days of Yellowstone Park, the formation of the town of Big Sky, the evolution of ranching and logging in the Northern Rockies and the preservation of the American West's spectacular wilderness. The Ranch was homesteaded by Clarence Lytle in 1915 as a working cattle and hay cutting ranch. A number of the current structures were originally built during the Ranch's first decade.

In 1927, the Ranch was sold to a Chicago paper mill executive, J. Fred Butler, who transformed the Ranch into a private vacation retreat for his family. In the 1930s, the next generation of the Butler family opened the Ranch to outside guests drawn to its spectacular natural setting and authentic western atmosphere. Following the Second World War, Lone Mountain Ranch was used as the base of a logging operation but in 1955 was converted back to a guest ranch.

In the early 1970s, the Ranch was purchased by a group of influential figures and investors developing the town of Big Sky. News anchor and Montana native Chet Huntley, ski legend Warren Miller and senior executives from Chrysler Corporation, Conoco and others entertained visitors at Lone Mountain Ranch and used the Ranch as their headquarters. In 1977, the Schaap family bought the Ranch to develop its potential as a mecca for cross country skiing. Over the next thirty years, they refined the Ranch's year-round guest experience, building upon the Ranch's rich heritage, natural beauty and numerous amenities. They also succeeded in solidifying Lone Mountain Ranch's position as a premier Nordic ski destination when the Ranch was rated #1 in North America by *Cross Country Skiing Magazine*.

In 2013, the Ranch was purchased by Auric Road who have restored and repositioned the property as a world class luxury guest ranch which is a frequent host to leading business executives, political leaders, celebrities and thought leaders from around the globe.


Horn & Cattle


Auric Room




Lone Mountain Rangers

The Ranch is as much a playground for children as it is for adults. This youth program builds confidence through outdoor recreation, develops an appreciation for nature, and most of all gives young people (aged 3-14) the space to roam, have fun, and connect with each other.
